

**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES ON ELEVATOR CODES  
AND ZIP LINES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT**

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION**

The Department of Labor and Workforce Development proposes to amend regulations by updating editions of the elevator safety standards code and adding a section on minimum safety requirements for the installation, assembly, repair, maintenance, operation, and inspection of zip lines. The department's proposed changes are set out in more detail in the notice of proposed regulations dated October 4, 2018.

This is a SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE adding to the NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES issued October 4, 2018 (Department of Law file number 2018200878). The SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE is being issued to provide additional opportunity for members of the public and other interested parties that were not notified by the GovDelivery, due to a technical error. This issue has now been corrected.

The comments must be received not later than 3:30 p.m. on November 23, 2018.

The Department will aggregate its response to substantially similar questions and make the questions and responses available on the Alaska Online Public Notice System.
