- 1. This is an open book examination based on the 2006 Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC and the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR's) 1926, Subpart P for Excavation. The only reference material permitted in the examination room will be the UPC and the CFR's.
- 2. Examination format consist of fifty (50) multiple choice and True/false questions.
- 3. Questions for the Uniform Plumbing Code are from the following Chapters and Appendices:
 - A. Chapter 1, (one) Administration, Sections 101.3 101.5.6, 103.5.1.1 103.5.1.4, 103.5.3 - 103.5.3.5, 103.5.5.1 - 103.5.5.2, 103.5.6.1 - 103.5.6.3, and 103.8.1 - 103.8.2
 - B. Chapter 2, (two) Definitions
 - C. Chapter 3, (three) General Regulations
 - D. Chapter 6, (six) Water Supply and Distribution
 - E. Chapter 7, (seven) Sanitary Drainage
 - F. Chapter 11, (eleven) Storm Drainage
