

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-03
RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE
ALASKA GASLINE INDUCEMENT ACT**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Workforce Investment Board is a public organization that is accountable through its members and staff to the residents, the Legislature and the Governor of Alaska;

WHEREAS, the Alaska Workforce Investment Board shall act as the lead state planning and coordinating entity for state human resource programs involving employment training, vocational education, and workforce development;

WHEREAS, Sec. 43.90.470 of the Alaska Gasline Inducement Act (AGIA) states the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development shall develop a job training program that will provide training for Alaskans in gas pipeline project management, construction, operations, maintenance, and other gas pipeline-related positions;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Workforce Investment Board officially supports and endorses AGIA offered by Governor Sarah Palin including a job training program developed by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development that will maximize Alaska hire and a Project Labor Agreement that will allow for timely completion of the project.
