

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-04
SUPPORTING THE WORK READY/COLLEGE READY
TRANSITIONAL SKILLS PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Workforce Investment Board is a public organization that is accountable through its members and staff to the residents, the Legislature and the Governor of Alaska;

WHEREAS, the Alaska Workforce Investment Board shall act as the lead state planning and coordinating entity for state human resource programs involving employment training, vocational education, and workforce development;


WHEREAS, proposed regulations under 4 AAC 06.715 and 4 AAC 06.717 would establish a program curriculum and benchmark assessments to ensure that students in Alaska have the basic or transitional skills required for successful transition into college and/or the workplace; and establishes the assessments to measure transitional skills;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Workforce Investment Board officially supports the proposed regulations under 4 AAC 06.715 and 4 AAC 06.717 and endorses the work ready/college ready transitional skills curriculum and benchmark assessments described in the regulations.
