Subject: **29 CFR 1910.33 through 1910.39 Subpart E – Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans, and Fire Prevention Plans**

This Program Directive, PD 03-05, is formal notice that Alaska Department of Labor & Workforce Development, Division of Labor Standards & Safety is implementing the OSHA revisions to 29 CFR 1910.33-1910.39, 1910.119, 1910.120, 1910.157, 1910.268 Subpart R, 1910.272 Subpart R, 1910.272 App A, 1910.1047, 1910.1050-51. This revision rewrote the existing requirements in clearer language, reorganized the text, removed inconsistencies and eliminated duplicative requirements. The subpart name was changed from “Means of Egress” to “Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans and Fire Prevention Plans”.

This program directive became effective December 9, 2002. Please ensure that all members of your staff receive a copy of the Federal Register showing the changes and this program directive, and understand how to implement it.
