Subject: SHARP Small Site Renewal Pilot Project

This Program Directive, PD 04-02, will implement the SHARP Small Site Renewal Pilot Project. This directive provides for a pilot project working with small site (fewer than 100 employees) SHARPS participants. It is designed to assist participants with renewal in SHARP.

This new pilot project will modify eligibility criteria to allow LWDII and TRCR to be calculated on the best two of the three most recent complete calendar years prior to renewal for certain small sites.
