This Partnership Program will follow OSHA guidelines and utilize information derived from TED 8-0.2; AKOSH Program Directive 03-01 High Hazard Targeting Plan annual lists; Consultation Policies and Procedures Manual (TED 3.6).

**Effective Date:** This program directive becomes effective immediately. All AKOSH staff are to receive the AKOSH Partnership Program and this program directive, and understand how to promote and implement it.
