## Aero Services Approved for Voluntary Protection Program

Greg O'Claray, the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development approved Aero Services in Ketchikan for the Alaska Occupational Safety and Health (AKOSH) Voluntary Protection Program (VPP) at the Merit level.

The Voluntary Protection Programs are designed to recognize and promote effective safety and health management. In the VPP management, labor, and AKOSH establish a cooperative relationship at a workplace that has implemented a strong safety and health program. Participation in the program is voluntary and does not exempt the worksite from AKOSH enforcement activities in case of employee complaints and accident investigations. However, the worksite is removed from general scheduled enforcement inspections for the approved period of time (from 18 months up to 5 years).

Federal OSHA first adopted the VPP on July 2, 1982. Alaska OSH offered the Voluntary Protection Program for Alaskan employers in December 1997.

At the present time there are seven companies with the VPP designation, including Aero Services. They are: BP Exploration Alaska, Inc., Central Power Station in Prudhoe Bay (VPP Star), Air Logistics of Alaska, Inc. in Fairbanks (VPP Star), UniSea, Inc. in Dutch Harbor (VPP Star), Insulfoam, Inc., in Anchorage (VPP Star), TelAlaska, Inc. in Dutch Harbor and in Seward (both VPP Merit).

Aero Services with its 13 employees in Ketchikan provide customer service for general aviation, to include: aircraft fueling, aircraft detailing, cargo, baggage handling, and aircraft parking. Their parent company Trajen Flight Support, LP also operates in Juneau, Sitka and Gustavus airports as well as other locations in the Lower 48.

The award ceremony will be held at the company site in Ketchikan, Alaska this fall.
