Occupational Safety and Health Board Sets Anchorage Hearings

(JUNEAU) – The Alaska Occupational Safety and Health Review Board has scheduled two days of hearings May 17-18 in Anchorage to consider challenges filed by employers contesting citations issued by the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

Citations are based on alleged violations of state occupational safety and health standards filed by the Division of Labor Standards and Safety.

Anchorage hearings will begin at 1:30 p.m. on May 17 in Room 402 of the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development at 1016 W. 6th Avenue, and will continue through May 18 as necessary.

Advance hearing notices are provided to all parties of contested citations. Board hearings are open to the public as required by Alaska statute.
