Occupational Safety and Health Review Board Sets Anchorage Hearings

JUNEAU – The Alaska Occupational Safety and Health Review Board has scheduled five days of hearings from Oct. 29 to Nov. 2 in Anchorage to consider challenges filed by employers contesting citations issued by the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

Citations are based on alleged violations of state occupational safety and health standards filed by the Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Labor Standards and Safety Division.

The first hearing will run two days, Oct. 29-30, and the second hearing will run three days, Oct. 31 and Nov. 1-2. They will begin each day at 9 a.m. in the Department of Labor and Workforce Development at 1016 W. Sixth Ave. in Room 402.

Advance hearing notices are provided to all parties of contested citations. Board hearings are open to the public as required by Alaska statute.
