(Juneau, AK) – Two chefs on the Alaska Vocational Technical Center instructional staff were recently honored by their peers.

Chef Robert Wilson, AVTEC's Culinary Academy department head, was named the Alaska Culinary Association's Chef of the Year on Monday at the association's annual gala at the Hotel Captain Cook in Anchorage.
