AVTEC's Automotive Technology Program Earns National Recertification

JUNEAU, Alaska— The Alaska Vocational Technical Center has received recertification for its automobile technician training program from the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation, Inc. A NATEF team evaluated AVTEC's programs for recertification in brakes, electrical electronic systems, engine performance, and heating and air conditioning.

"I commend our staff for maintaining program standards and continuing to meet increasingly demanding industry requirements," AVTEC Director Fred Esposito said. "The explosion in automotive technology makes AVTEC's high quality automotive training program more valuable than ever."

In addition to its automotive program in Seward, AVTEC offers 16 long-term training programs ranging from six weeks to 11 months and about 60 short-term training programs that can be completed in a week to six weeks. AVTEC's main campus is in Seward, while classes for the school's Allied Health program are held in Anchorage. Nearly all of AVTEC's training programs are available statewide through remote-site and distance-delivery classes.
