Veterans Job Fair Nov. 10 in Anchorage

JUNEAU, Alaska—More than 60 employers, apprenticeship and training providers are expected at the Veterans Job Fair in Anchorage tomorrow (Tuesday, Nov. 10) at the Muldoon Job Center.

Lt. Gov. Craig Campbell will keynote the opening ceremony at 10 a.m., with posting of the colors by the West High School Junior ROTC Color Guard. A special recognition award will be presented by Anchorage School District Superintendent Carol Comeau.

“Alaska is home to more than 75,000 veterans and their family members, the largest per capita population of veterans in the nation,” Labor Commissioner Click Bishop said. “Our Alaska Job Center Network served more than 13,000 veterans last year.”

The job fair is open to the public and there is no fee to attend. Job seekers are encouraged to bring a resume and dress for potential interviews.
