## **Unemployment rate at 6.7 percent in January**

Alaska's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 6.7 percent in January, essentially unchanged from December's 6.6 percent. The comparable national rate was 7.9 percent, also just one-tenth of a percentage point higher than the previous month.


All 2012 unemployment data for both the U.S. and Alaska were revised early this year as part of the normal annual revision process. Alaska's seasonally adjusted rate was revised down substantially for several months mid-year.

Alaska's rate kicked off 2013 at a lower level than in 2012, continuing a bumpy downward trend in the seasonally adjusted rate since its peak in early 2010. Compared to January 2010, the U.S rate has fallen 1.9 percentage points, and the Alaska rate has fallen 1.5 percentage points.

Not-seasonally adjusted rates increased in all but three of Alaska's boroughs and census areas, which is a normal seasonal occurrence. Kodiak Island and Aleutians East boroughs and Aleutians West Census Area were the only areas where the rate fell due to winter openings in several fisheries.

Area unemployment rates were down over the year in all but nine boroughs or census areas. All the regions with increased unemployment rates are coastal, suggesting that winter fisheries-related hiring may not be as robust in 2013 as it was in 2012.
