Executive Proclamation by Governor Bill Walker

WHEREAS, all Alaskans deserve to live in communities that promote safe and healthy living environments, and safe communities require the cooperation of all levels of government, business, and industry employees, as well as the general public; and

WHEREAS, through the support and observance of National Safety Month each year, employers are helping to reverse an increase in accidental injuries and deaths in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska works to prevent accidental injuries and deaths by educating Alaskans about safe and health practices in the workplace, on our roads and highways, and in our homes and communities; and

WHEREAS, this year's National Safety Month theme, "What I Live For," was established to help members of the public avoid accidents by focusing on provide internal motivations for good safety habits; and

WHEREAS, Alaskans are encouraged to share stories with their community about the importance of safety at work and at home including: distracted driving awareness, hazard avoidance, emergency preparedness, and preventing the abuse of prescription painkillers or other substances;


