


Goal 2: The Committee will evaluate the satisfaction of current transition services and will solicit input regarding how services can be more effective.

- The Evaluation Committee, a subcommittee of the Governor’s Committee on Employment & Rehabilitation of People with Disabilities developed a survey to measure what is occurring in the state in terms of transition services for young people who have a disability. Cover letters and surveys were distributed to parents and educators at **the IDEA Boot Camp** and the Special Education Training for Parents and Educators. ■ Purple Survey - Parents from the IDEA Boot Camp & Special Education Training for Parents and Educators - 12% return
■ Blue Survey - Special Educators from the IDEA Boot Camp & Special Education Training for Parents and Educators - 16% return
■ Yellow Survey - Parents and Special Educators mailout - 21% return

Transition Survey Conclusions:

1. While Special Education staff indicated they were relatively familiar with both State and Tribal VR, the services these agencies provide and knew whom to contact, the families were not as well informed.
2. Both educators and families indicated that very few had had a VR counselor present information about transition services to their students.

Neither group surveyed was familiar with or aware of the Department of Education SET For Life website.
