SUBJECT: Individual Funding Limits

This advisory is to provide DETS staff with individual funding limits for Program Year 2021/State Fiscal Year 2022.

To ensure effective and efficient use of training and support services funds, the limits are based on individual employment plans (IEP), for new enrollees. TET DWG may be used for either service. STEP funds may be used for either service but cannot exceed \$10,000.

The total funding for an individual plan may not exceed \$20,000 for all programs combined.

The limits are as follows:

Table with 3 columns: Program, Training Services, Support Services. Rows include WIOA Adult, WIOA Dislocated Worker, Trade and Economic Transition - TET DWG, STEP, ASE, and Additional support for STEP sub-award participants.

The Assistant Director of Workforce Services, or designee, is authorized to approve exceptions to the WIOA Adult, Dislocated Worker and DWG program limits. Exceptions to STEP are not permitted.
