SUBJECT: WIOA & SCSEP Common Performance Indicators – Negotiated Rates

The purpose of this advisory is to provide the Program Year (PY) 2020 and PY 2021 negotiated levels of performance for the WIOA Adult, Dislocated Worker, Youth, Wagner Peyser, Alaska Adult Education, and Senior Community Services Employment Program.

WIOA sec. 116(b)(3)(A)(iv) mandates that States will negotiate performance outcomes every two years. Factors taken into consideration during the negotiation process include utilizing a statistical adjustment model to incorporate actual economic conditions such as the unemployment rate and job losses or gains in particular industries; and characteristics of the program participants e.g. poor work history, lack of educational or occupational skills attainment, dislocation from high-wage, high-benefit employment, low levels of literacy or English proficiency, disability status, homelessness, ex-offender status and welfare dependency. Also examined is the extent to which the levels involved promote continuous improvement to ensure optimal return on the investment of Federal funds.

Representatives from the Alaska Workforce Investment Board and Division of Employment and Training Services negotiated performance levels with the US Department of Labor and US Department of Education for each performance indicator. The results are listed on page 2 and are effective July 1, 2020.
