UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS

- Total Alaskan labor force is 342,148
- The total number of people receiving a UI payment for at least one week is 51,120
- The total benefit dollars paid for this period is \$112,053,165
- The largest daily UI payout was \$2,703,358.22
- \$193.91 is the average weekly amount paid out to claimants
- The average duration of UI for a claimant is 14.35 weeks
- The statewide unemployment rate averaged 6.8%. It was lowest in August at 5.8% and highest in February at 8.2%
- 92% of the clients use the automated telephone claims filing system
- The Anchorage, Fairbanks and Juneau claim centers responded to 261,415 phone calls from claimants

ΤΑΧ

- 17,564 employers are registered in Alaska
- 60% of registered employers have fewer than 10 employees
- Over 71,555 Contribution Reports have been processed
- \$177,760,329.06 was deposited in the UI Tax Trust Account
- \$11,010,222.14 was collected and deposited into the accounts of the State Training and Employment Program and the Alaska Technical and Vocational Education Program
- Over \$1,428,852 quarterly wage records were added to the wage file
- Over \$3,546,976.28 was refunded to Alaskan employers who overpaid their taxes
