DECISION AND ORDER CONCERNING
PETITION NUMBER 1-73

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Petitioner, Alaska Tri Trades Public Service Council, has filed a petition requesting certification as the bargaining agency for a unit consisting of all construction maintenance and custodial employees employed by the State of Alaska, within and without the State of Alaska excluding elected or appointed officials within the meaning of AS 23.10.140.260, and supervisory and confidential employees.

2. Petitioner alleged a showing of interest of over 30 percent, as required under the Public Employment Relations Act.

3. Pursuant to 2 AAC 10.060 the Labor Relations Agency investigated the petition and found that there are currently 804 employees in the classifications petitioned for and was able to verify individual authorizations for 175 or 21.8 percent of the total unit requested.

CONCLUSION

1. Petitioner has not made a sufficient showing of interest as required by 2 AAC 10.020.

ORDER

Petition Number 1-73 is dismissed.
