ORDER AND DECISION NO. 26A PERTAINING
TO UNIT ALLOCATION OF INDIVIDUALS

FINDINGS OF FACT

On July 23, 1976, the Division of Personnel, Department of Administration, State of Alaska proposed to move about 250 individuals from the Supervisory Unit to the General Government Unit. There was no objection to this proposal from either the individuals concerned or the Alaska Public Employees Association, the collective bargaining representative of both Units. The proposed moves were based upon questionnaires filled out by the individuals concerned, said questionnaires being designed to determine whether or not those concerned met the criteria set forth under the regulations of the Labor Relations Agency at 2 AAC 10.220 (b) (3).

CONCLUSION

The Division of Personnel's proposal was proper and should be granted.
