ORDER AND DECISION NO. 29 PERTAINING
TO CLARIFICATION OF UNIT - RADIO OFFICERS

FINDINGS OF FACT

The positions of Chief Radio Officer and Radio Officer in the Alaska State Division of Marine Transportation were included in the General Government Unit by oversight.

The community of interest of persons in these positions is clearly with the crews of the Marine Ferries, and particularly with the Inland Boatmen's Union. In addition, the other criteria of the Public Employment Relations Act would be better satisfied by clarification of the General Government Unit and the Inland Boatmen's Union Unit by removing these positions from the General Government Unit and placing them in the Unit represented by the Inland Boatmen's Union.

CONCLUSION

The positions of Chief Radio Officer and Radio Officer in the Alaska State Division of Marine Transportation should be removed from the General Government Unit represented by the Alaska Public Employees Association and placed in the Unit of Marine Ferry Personnel represented by the Inland Boatmen's Union.

ORDER AND DECISION NO. 29

As of February 20, 1977, the positions of Chief Radio Officer and Radio Officer in the Alaska State Division of Marine Transportation shall be removed from the Unit of General Government Employees represented by the Alaska Public Employees Association and shall be placed in the Unit of Marine Ferry Employees represented by the Inland Boatmen's Union.
