ORDER AND DECISION NO. 43 PERTAINING
TO UNIT CLARIFICATION PETITION, 78-7
BY PUBLIC EMPLOYEES LOCAL 71 AFL-CIO
PERTAINING TO THE CLASSIFICATION OF
JACK BRADFORD

On August 18, 1978 Public Employees Local 71 submitted a petition for unit classification (UC 78-7). In that petition Local 71 contended that Mr. Jack Bradford, classified as a Supply Clerk I in the General Government bargaining Unit represented by the Alaska Public Employees Association, was in reality performing functions of a Store Keeper, Wage Group 8 in the Bargaining Unit represented by Local 71.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The hearing on the petition was held on February 21 and 22, 1979. After consideration of the testimony presented at the hearing and the documentary evidence submitted by the parties, the Alaska Labor Relations Agency finds that the primary duties performed by the employee, Mr. Jack Bradford, are those of a Supply Clerk I. While Mr. Bradford did perform the duties of a Store Keeper, he did so only on a temporary basis.

CONCLUSION

The Alaska Labor Relations Agency concludes that the position occupied by Mr. Bradford is appropriately classified as a Supply Clerk I in the General Government unit represented by APEA.

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It is the order of the Alaska Labor Relations Agency that the petition 78-7 submitted by the Public Employees Local 71 is hereby denied.
