ORDER AND DECISION NO. 46 PERTAINING  
TO THE UNIT CLARIFICATION PETITION,  
UC-78-2 REGARDING SUPERVISING NURSE  
II'S AND PIONEER HOME MANAGERS

On September 6, 1978, the Alaska Public Employees Association filed petition (UC 78-2) seeking to include the Pioneer Home Managers and Supervisory Nurse II's working at the Pioneer Homes in its bargaining unit.

FINDINGS OF FACT

A hearing was held on April 19, 1979. After considering testimony presented at the hearings and the documentary evidence submitted by the parties, the Alaska Labor Relations Agency finds that the incumbents filling the position of Supervising Nurse II at the Pioneer Homes regularly perform supervisory functions. They are the number two persons in the hierarchy at the Pioneer Homes and may be responsible of the work of up to forty (40) workers.

The Pioneer Home Managers are in the partially exempt service.

CONCLUSION

The Alaska Labor Relations Agency concludes that the incumbents of Supervising Nurse II positions are supervisory employees as that term is used in 2 AAC 10.220(b) (3) and that these individuals should be in the supervisory unit represented. The Agency does not believe that it would be

appropriate to include members of the partially exempt service in a bargaining unit which consists primarily of members of the classified service.

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It is the order of the Alaska Labor Relations Agency that the petition of the Alaska Public Employees Association is granted with regard to the proposed transfer of the Supervising Nurse II position's from the General Government Unit to the Supervisory Unit and denied with respect to the inclusion of the Pioneer Home Managers in the Supervisory Unit.
