ORDER AND DECISION NO. 88

The Alaska Labor Relations Agency has received petition 84-4 petitioning for a group of employees as defined by 2 AAC 220 excluding supervisors at the Alaska Community Colleges.

The Labor Relations Agency DENIES the petition, subject to the petitioners ability to show that the showing of interest cards submitted equal 30% of the employees of the proposed bargaining unit pursuant to Alaska Statue 23.40.100, and 2 AAC 10.030 (b) which specifies that a petition shall be accompanied by showing of interest of not less than 30% of the employees in the unit...".

The agencies investigation concluded that the 30% of showing of interest was not met by the petitioner. The agencies investigation included in house visits to each Community College, double checking the employees list for accuracy, deleting

employees on the employees list who did not teach at a Community College, and a thorough review of the showing of interest cards and the lists.

The petitioner shall have until June 29, 1984 to contact counsel for the agency and show what individuals who signed "Showing Of Interest" cards should be included in the unit, and that the 30% requirement is met. This order is to take effect this date.
