Since October 2019, City of Wasilla's Public Works Department has been working with the Consultation and Training section to improve occupational safety and health conditions for employees.

AKOSH consultants conducted a comprehensive safety and health evaluation in October 2022 and May 2023 which verified the site meets the SHARP eligibility criteria. You have exhibited commitment and hard work toward this goal, and the recommendations our consultants made were received freely and implemented to the effect of enhancing your program. Participation in SHARP does not diminish any of the rights and responsibilities provided to you and your employees by the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970. Although the name of your site will be removed from the scheduled inspection list for two years from the date of this letter, employee complaints, fatalities or catastrophes, and significant chemical leaks or spills at your site will still result in normal AKOSH Enforcement activities.
