To Whom it May Concern:

Enclosed is an errata to the current PWR effective June 1, 2002. The Laborer basic rate will be reduced by 50 cents per hour from the basic rate and the health benefit will be increased by 50 cents per hour.

This will, of course, apply to all contracts let from June 11, 2002 forward.

However, all signatory employers must pay the new rate regardless of what their bid specs may have called for. In order to keep matters equitable, from June 1 forward the Department will allow all contractors, Union and non-union, to pay the adjusted rate to laborer categories on any ongoing project. This is being done to avoid any unfair advantage that might otherwise exist because of the overtime impacts of reducing the basic rate of pay.
