Note: a typographical error has been corrected in item 1 correcting the citation from 29 CFR 19.1020 to 29 CFR 1910.1020.

This Program Directive, PD 06-11, is notice that Alaska Department of Labor & Workforce Development, Division of Labor Standards & Safety will incorporate the Final Rule updating 29 CFR Part 1910 and 29 CFR 1926 based on the corrections and technical amendments as published in the Federal Register in Vol. 71, No. 63 pp16669-16675 on April 3, 2006. Changes to 29 CFR 1913 and 1915 will not be adopted since they are currently outside Alaska's jurisdiction.

Effective Date: April 12, 2006

Reference: OSHA, in reviewing its regulations, has found some errors, some incorrect references and some obsolete provisions which it is now correcting. This action will improve employer and employee understanding of the affected provisions. These revisions do not affect substantive requirements or coverage of standards involved, nor do they establish new rights or obligations.

1. **29 CFR 1910**

OSHA is removing references to 29 CFR 1910.20 and replacing it with reference to 29 CFR ~~19.1020~~ **1910.1020** in the following:

2. **29 CFR 1926**

OSHA is removing references to 29 CFR 1910.20 and replacing it with reference to 29 CFR 1926.33 in the following:

1926.60	Methylenedianiline	1926.62	Lead
1926.800	Underground Construction	1926.1101	Asbestos

3. **29 CFR 1910.1020 Access to employee exposure and medical records**

Correcting reference in paragraph (F)(4)(v) from paragraph (f)(9) to paragraph (f) (7) with regard to release of trade secret information to OSHA.

4. **29 CFR 1910.1027 & 1026.1127 - Cadmium**

References to Appendix "C" (Deleted) have been removed – paragraph (q)(1)

5. **29 CFR 1910.1028 – benzene**

References to Appendix E (deleted) have been removed – paragraph (n)

6. **29 CFR 1910.1048 – Formaldehyde**

References to Appendix E (deleted) have been removed from Appendix A

7. **29 CFR 1910.1050 and 1926.60 – Methylenedianiline**

Change references to paragraph (o) not (n) with regard to maintaining records of correction actions

Remove references to Appendix E (deleted) in both these standards.

8. **29 CFR 1910.1051 – 1,3-Butadiene**

Paragraph (n) is removed because the start-up dates have expired. A sentence has been added to (d) referencing the one start up-date that was retained.

9. **29 CFR 1926.62 – Lead**

References to paragraph (1)(2)(ii)(C) are being removed in paragraph (d)(2)(v)(F) and referencing paragraph (1)(2)(iii) instead.

10. **29 CFR 1926.754 – Structural Steel Assembly**

Slip resistance of metal decking is being removed.

Please ensure that all members of your staff receive a copy of the Federal Register for Monday, April 03, 2006 (pp 16669-16675) detailing the changes and revised language, and this program directive and understand how to implement these revisions.
