Subject: **Implementation of Priority System for AKOSH Consultation Requests**

This Program Directive, PD 08-02, is notice that Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Division of Labor Standards and Safety will implement the following priority system for AKOSH consultation requests:

1. Imminent danger site visits.
2. Small High Hazard employers targeted in the State Strategic Plan, Local Emphasis Program, or other "Targeted Industries," or AKOSH Strategic Partnership Program (less than 250 employees on site and less than 500 employees Corporation wide).
3. Small High Hazard employers who are in a high-hazard industry or who have the highest incidence rates (per TED 3.6)(less than 250 employees on site and less than 500 employees Corporation wide).
4. Small, Non-High Hazard Employers (less than 250 employees on site and less than 500 employees Corporation wide).
5. Larger Employers (more than 250 employees on site and/or more than 500 corporation wide).
