

This Program Directive, PD 10-05, is formal notice that the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Division of Labor Standards and Safety recognizes and will implement the Enforcement Procedures for High to Very High Occupational Exposure Risk to 2009 H1N1 Influenza.

This directive will become effective on December 31, 2009. This directive establishes agency enforcement policies and provides instruction to ensure uniform procedures when conducting inspection to minimize high to very high occupational exposure risk to the virus identified as 2009 H1N1 influenza of workers who occupational activities involve contact with patients or contaminated material in a healthcare or clinical laboratory setting.
