DOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE 90-4

Subject: OSHA Technical Manual

1. Purpose: The purpose of DOSH PD 90-4 is to incorporate the OSHA Technical Manual. It replaces the Industrial Health Technical Manual that was adopted on April 28, 1987 under OSH Industrial Hygiene Technical Manual Change Letter (IHTMCL) No. 87-1.
2. Letters Affected: IHTMCL 87-1 is cancelled and the Alaska Industrial Hygiene Technical Manual adopted on April 28, 1987 is rescinded. However, industrial hygienists may want to keep Appendix A, Chemical Information Table, from the 1987 IH Technical Manual for reference purposes. Another good reference is CPL 2-2.43, the Chemical Information Manual, dated October 20, 1987.
3. Background: On February 5, 1990, federal OSHA replaced their Industrial Hygiene Technical Field Manual with the OSHA Technical Manual (OTM) published as OSHA Instruction CPL 2-20B. Alaska OSH has decided to adopt the OSHA OTM as is with only changes to reference applicable Alaska OSH standards and to refer to the contract laboratory rather than the federal OSHA's Salt Lake or Cincinnati laboratories.
4. Action: This directive is effective immediately and will remain in effect until modified or superseded.
