Subject: **Standard for Dipping and Coating Operations (Dip Tanks), Final Rule.**

This program directive, PD 99-05 implemented the *Final Rule on Dipping and Coating Operations*: 29 CFR 1910.7, .94, .108, and .121-.126 has been amended. In 1985, the state began adopting federal regulation changes by reference under 8 AAC 61.1010(a), however 29 CFR 1910.6 was not included under that section. We continue to work on our regulation clean up and hope to have it completed in the near future. Subsection .6 will be reviewed as part of that project.

This amended standard is attached and becomes part of this program directive. PD 99-05 conveys the attached final rule for 29 CFR 1910.7, .94, .108, and .121-.126, which was published in the Federal Register on March 23, 1999, in Volume 64, No. 55. This program directive became effective June 21, 1999. Please ensure that all members of your staff receive this program directive, a copy of the standard, and understand how to implement it.
